**RE: Distributed Energy Resources**

Witness Hutson states that “conducting a DEA on the entire 80 MW portfolio of distributed solar would be difficult, if not impossible, when ‘PSE had not procured nor fully determined the customer program structure for the entire 80 MW portfolio of distributed solar that was to be in place by the end of 2025 pursuant to the Clean Energy Implementation Plan approved target.” Exh. TAH-10T at 19:3-7. Please explain (1) how much of the 80 mw portfolio has PSE procured as of the date of this DR, and (2) for how much of the remaining balance of the 80 MW portfolio has PSE determined the customer program structure.

**Response:**

- (1) As of the date of this Data Request, Puget Sound Energy has procured 29 MW of the 80 MW primarily through Net Energy Metering (“NEM”) and Community Solar.
- (2) The remaining 51 MWs are expected through a combination of the following projects and customer programs:
  - Community Solar Project Services (Schedule 134)
  - RFP Projects
  - Net Metering Services for Customer-Generator Systems (Schedule 150)
  - Purchases from Distributed Solar Photovoltaic Systems (Schedule 667)
  - Solar Energy Credit Multi-Occupant Allocation Service (Schedule 686)
  - Department of Commerce Solar Plus Storage for Resilient Communities Program
