BACKGROUND

- 1 By Order entered in Docket No. UE-001951 on December 13, 2000, the Commission allowed a new tariff Schedule 71, Energy Exchange Pilot Program, filed by PacifiCorp d/b/a/ Pacific Power & Light (PacifiCorp) to become effective on less than statutory notice. The Order also required 1) PacifiCorp to make its curtailment price offers publicly available at its offices in Washington and at the Commission, and 2) periodic reports to be filed with the Commission in a form and on a schedule sent by the Secretary.
- 2 On April 1, 2001, the Commission allowed tariff revisions to Schedule 71, to become effective. The revisions included an extension of the pilot program termination to October 31, 2001. The Commission entered an Order Requiring Reporting in Docket No. UE-010250.
- 3 On September 28, 2001, PacifiCorp filed tariff revisions to Schedule 71, which include an extension of the termination date to October 31, 2002. The Commission allowed revisions to become effective on November 1, 2001.
- 4 PacifiCorp agrees to continue to comply with the public disclosure of current curtailment price offers required by Order in Docket No. UE-001951.
- 5 PacifiCorp agrees to file semi-annual reports on participation and key aspects of the voluntary curtailments during the extension period.

- 6 This matter was heard by the Commission at its regularly scheduled meeting of October 31, 2001. The Commissioners, having been fully advised in the matter, and having determined this order to be consistent with the public interest, directed the Secretary to enter this order.

ORDER

THE COMMISSION ORDERS:

- 7 PacifiCorp d/b/a/ Pacific Power & Light must file semi-annual reports with the Commission in a form and on a schedule established by letter from the Secretary.
