Per your departments request enclosed is the permission to mortgage a certificate on the updated form taken from your website, plus the necessary fees associated with obtaining the mortgage.

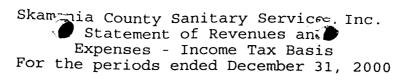
