("Allegiance") hereby gives notice that it is adopting the interconnection agreement between GTE Northwest Incorporated (n/k/a Verizon Northwest Inc.) and Covad Communications Company approved by the Commission in Docket UT-990341, and subsequently amended by those parties to date.

The initial term of the Covad Agreement ran from May 4, 1999 to May 4, 2001, subject to consecutive one year renewal terms in the absence of timely notice of termination.
