This application for authority is part of implementation of the Commission's mapping project. It was discovered that a portion of Eastern Washington was not within any existing certificate of convenience and necessity. It appeared initially that the unclaimed authority was within the territory served by Empire Disposal, Inc., who then filed Application No. GA-079114 for an extension. Waste Management protested, partly because it was already serving within the unclaimed territory. Individuals familiar with the operations of the two companies met, and clarified between them who was serving where. As a result, in order to bring the two companies' certificates in line with actual operations, with this application, Waste Management is seeking approval for an extension of its authority; and the companies are concurrently seeking approval to have a portion of Empire Disposal's authority transferred to Waste Management (under separate application), and a portion of Waste Management's authority transferred to Empire Disposal (under separate application).



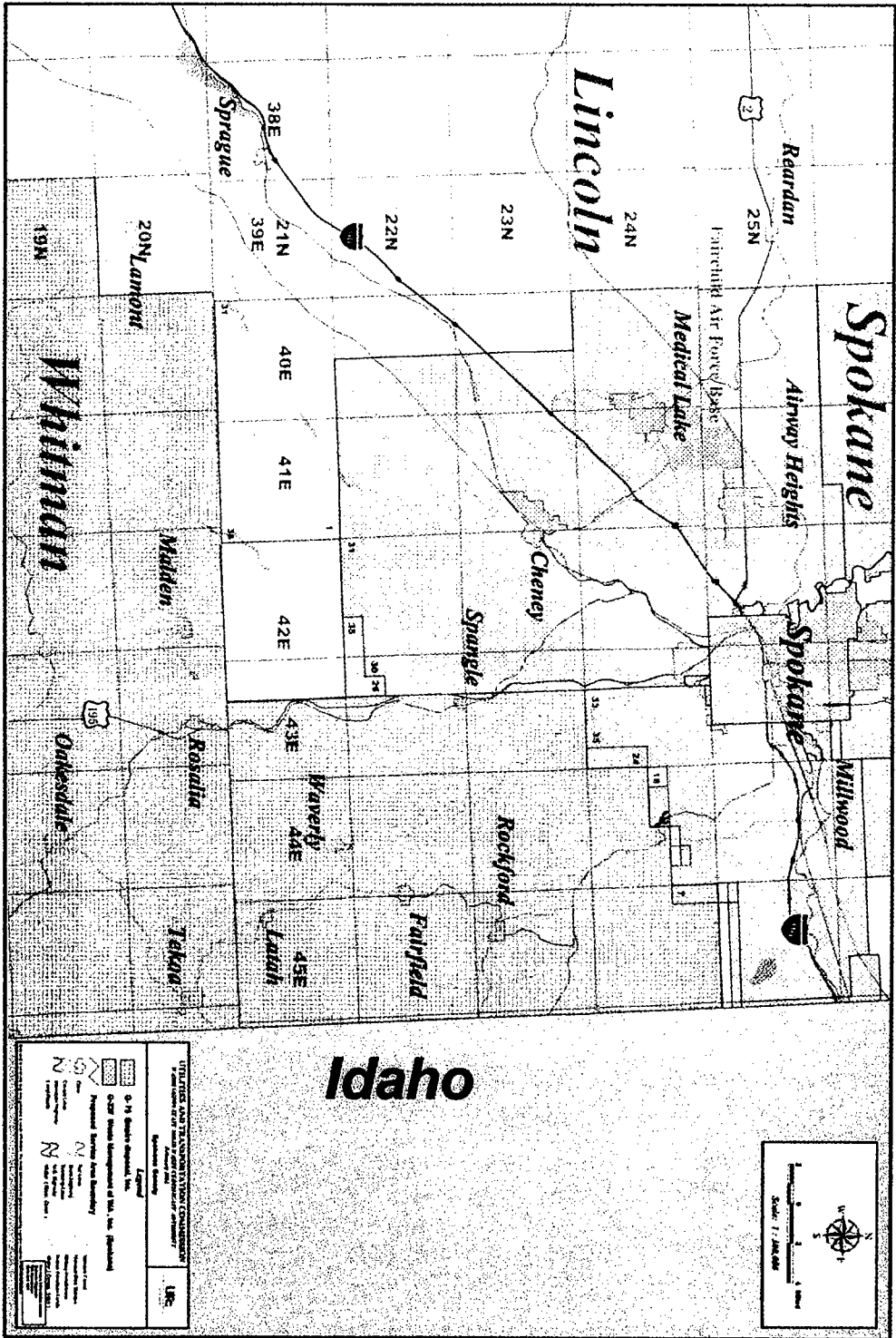
