SALE AGREEMENT

This Agreement is dated as of April 30th, 2003 by and between Robert J. Pellegrini, d/b/a Upper Valley Disposal ("Seller") and Couse's Sanitation & Recycle, Inc., a Washington corporation ("Buyer").

Seller is the holder of Certificate of Convenience and necessity No. G-21 issued by the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (the "WUTC") which covers, in part, the specific territory described on Exhibit A attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference (the "Territory"). Seller desires to sell and Buyer desires to purchase the Territory.

In consideration of One Dollar (\$1.00) the purchase price, and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, the parties hereto hereby agree as follows:

1. Transfer. In accordance with the provisions of this Agreement, Seller hereby transfers, conveys, sells, assigns and delivers to Buyer, its successors and assigns, forever, the authority to perform solid waste collection services in the Territory effective as of the Closing date.

2. Counterparts. This Agreement may be executed in any number of original or facsimile counterparts, and each counterpart hereof shall be deemed to be an original instrument, but all such counterparts shall constitute one instrument.

3. Entire Agreement. This Agreement constitutes the entire agreement among the parties and supersedes any prior understandings, agreements, or representations by or among the parties, written or oral, to the extent they related in any way to the subject matter hereof. This Agreement may only be amended by a written agreement executed by all of the parties hereto.


EXHIBIT B

Since 1972 the requested territory has been served by either Dewayne Couse, Clifford W. Couse, d/b/a Couse's Sanitation or Couse's Sanitation and Recycle, Inc. G-169. This request for transfer is being done because it was discovered during the WUTC meets and bounds effort, that the original map and description were incorrect, in that it did not go quite far enough into Okanogan County to cover the Wauconda Store and Café and a portion of Toroda Creek that was being serviced under G-169. The customers in this area have always been served by us, they have received notification of rate increases, and have been billed under G-169 Tariff rates. This is a remote area and Mr. Pellegrine does not want to provide service there as it would not be cost effective for the customers or his Company to do it.

There has been no attempt to harm Mr. Pellegrini nor the customers, it was simply an oversight by both companies as to the true boundaries of our respective territories.

We are requesting the Commission approve this joint transfer.

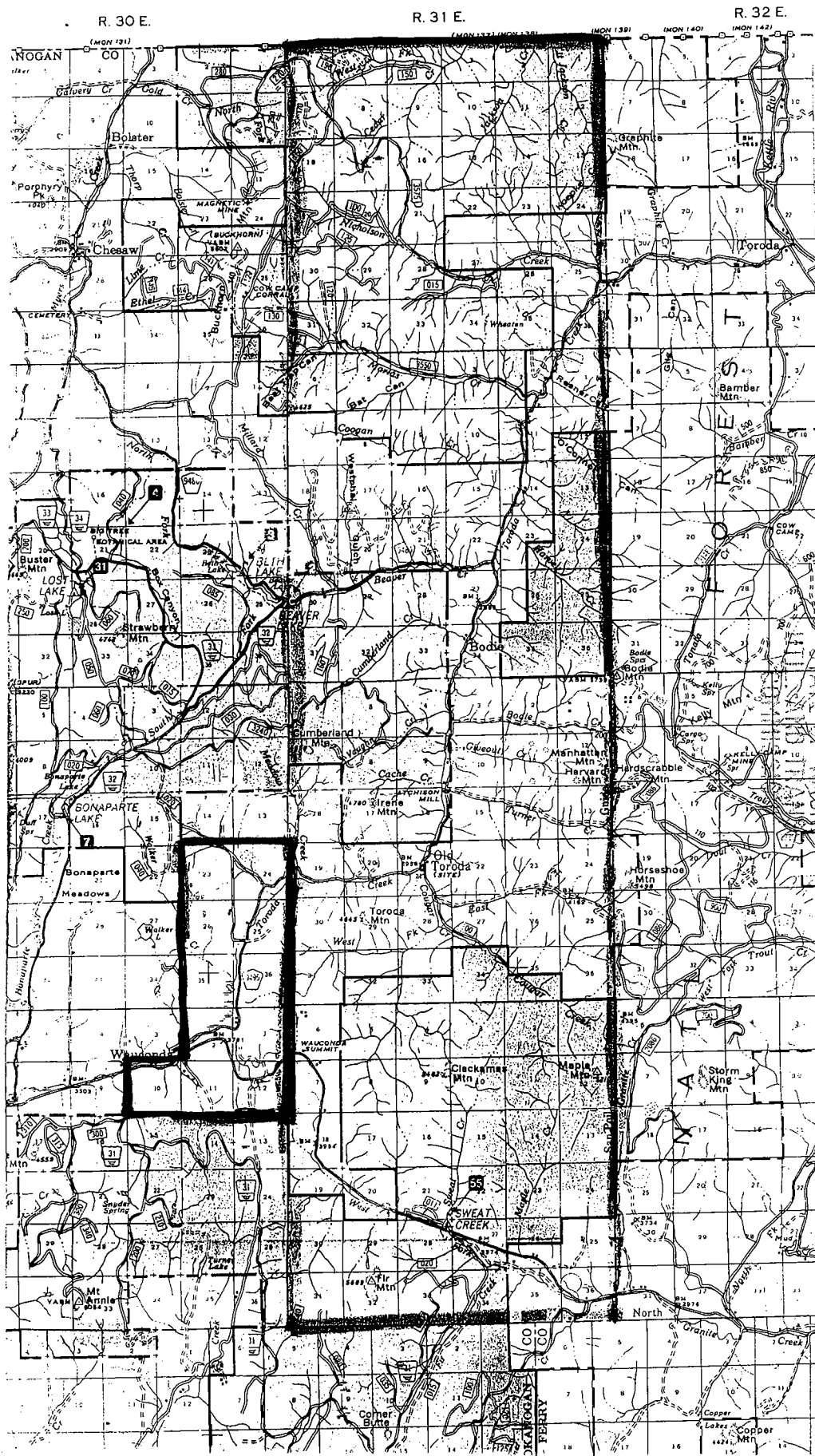
