PETITION OF

GRANITE TELECOMMUNICATIONS, LLC

DOCKET NO. <u>UT-040142</u>

Granite Telecommunications, LLC ("Granite" or "Petitioner") hereby petitions the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission ("Commission") for a waiver of Washington Administrative Code ("WAC") 480-120-540. In support of its Petition, Granite states as follows:

- 1. Granite is a Competitive Telecommunications Company, approved in Docket No. 031385 on September 27, 2003, and authorized to provide resold interexchange and resold and facilities-based local exchange telecommunications services in Washington.
- 2. On December 7, 1999, in Docket No. UT 970325, the Commission adopted WAC 480-120-540. WAC 480-120-540 only permits a local exchange company to include in its terminating switched access rates a charge for recovery of any costs for support of universal access to basic telecommunications service when authorized by the Commission.
- 3. Granite is not currently authorized by the Commission to include in its terminating switched access rates a charge for recovery of costs for support of univeral access to basic telecommunicatons service.
- 4. On or about September 7, 1999, the Commission entered its Order Denying

  Petition for Declaratory Order, Granting Waiver of WAC 480-120-540 in Docket No. UT 
  990307. In that Order, the Commission required petitioners to file price lists for terminating

  access service at rates not to exceed those charged by U.S. West Communications, Inc. and GTE

  Northwest Incorporated in their respective service territories.

On or about August 30, 2000, the Commission entered its Order Granting Waiver

of WAC 480-120-540, Terminating Access Charges, in Docket UT-001257. In that Order, the

Commission required petitioner to file price lists for terminating access service at rates not to

exceed those charged by Qwest Corporation, f/k/a U.S. West Communications, Inc. ("Qwest"),

and Verizon Northwest Incorporated, f/k/a GTE Northwest Incorporated ("Verizon"), in their

respective service territories.

6. Granite has filed revised pages to its Price List No. 2, Intrastate Access, in which

it has establish terminating access rates that do not exceed the terminating switched rates charged

by Qwest or Verizon, consistent with the requirements in the Orders in Docket Nos. UT-990307

and UT-001257.

5.

WHEREFORE, Granite requests the following relief:

That the Commission grant Granite a waiver of WAC 480-120-540 so that A.

Granite may include in its terminating switched access rates a charge for recovery of costs for

support of universal access to basic telecommunications service, as previously granted to

petitioners in Dockets UT-990307 and UT-0012576; and

B. Such other or further relief as the Commission finds fair, just, reasonable and

sufficient.
