

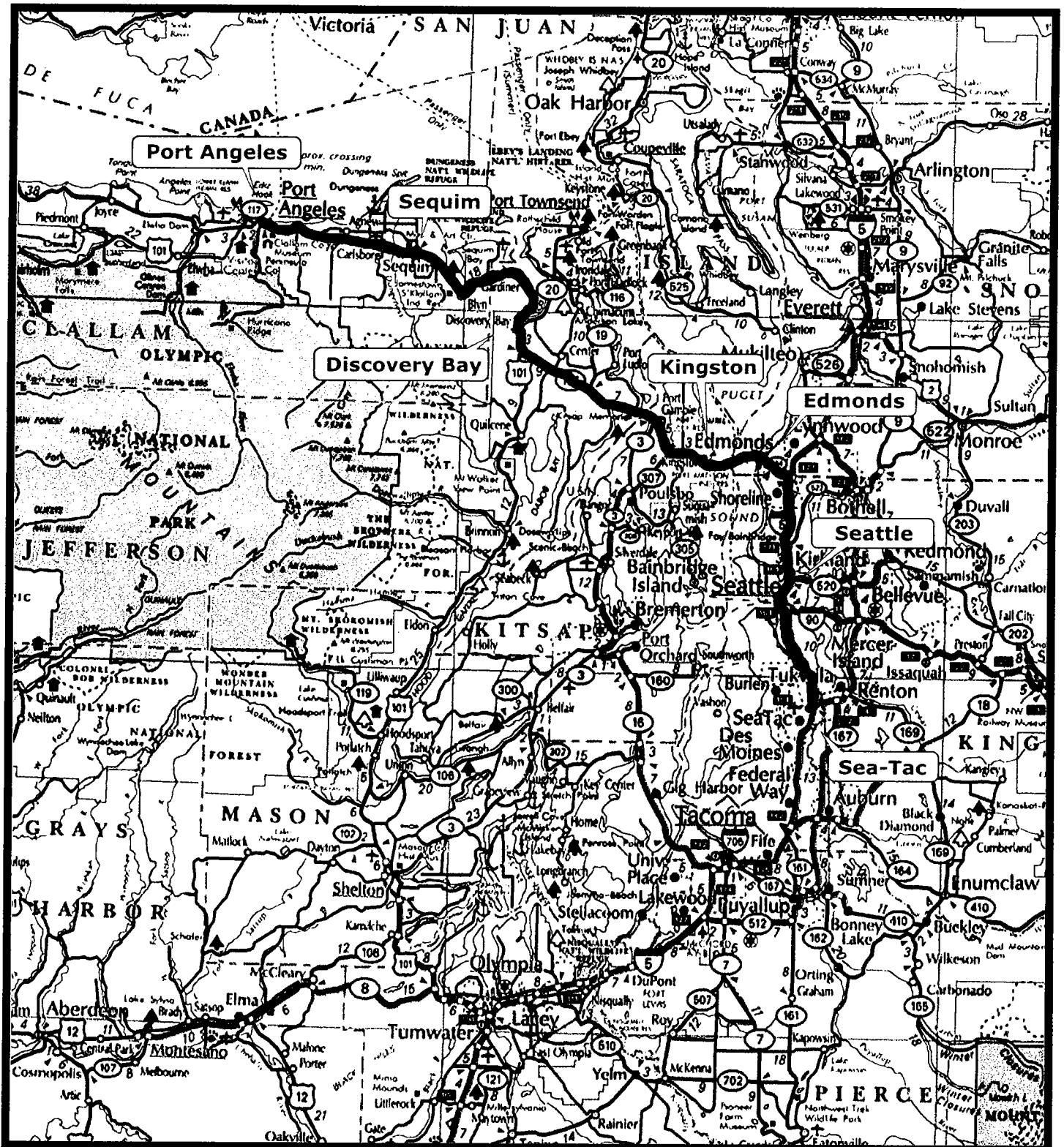

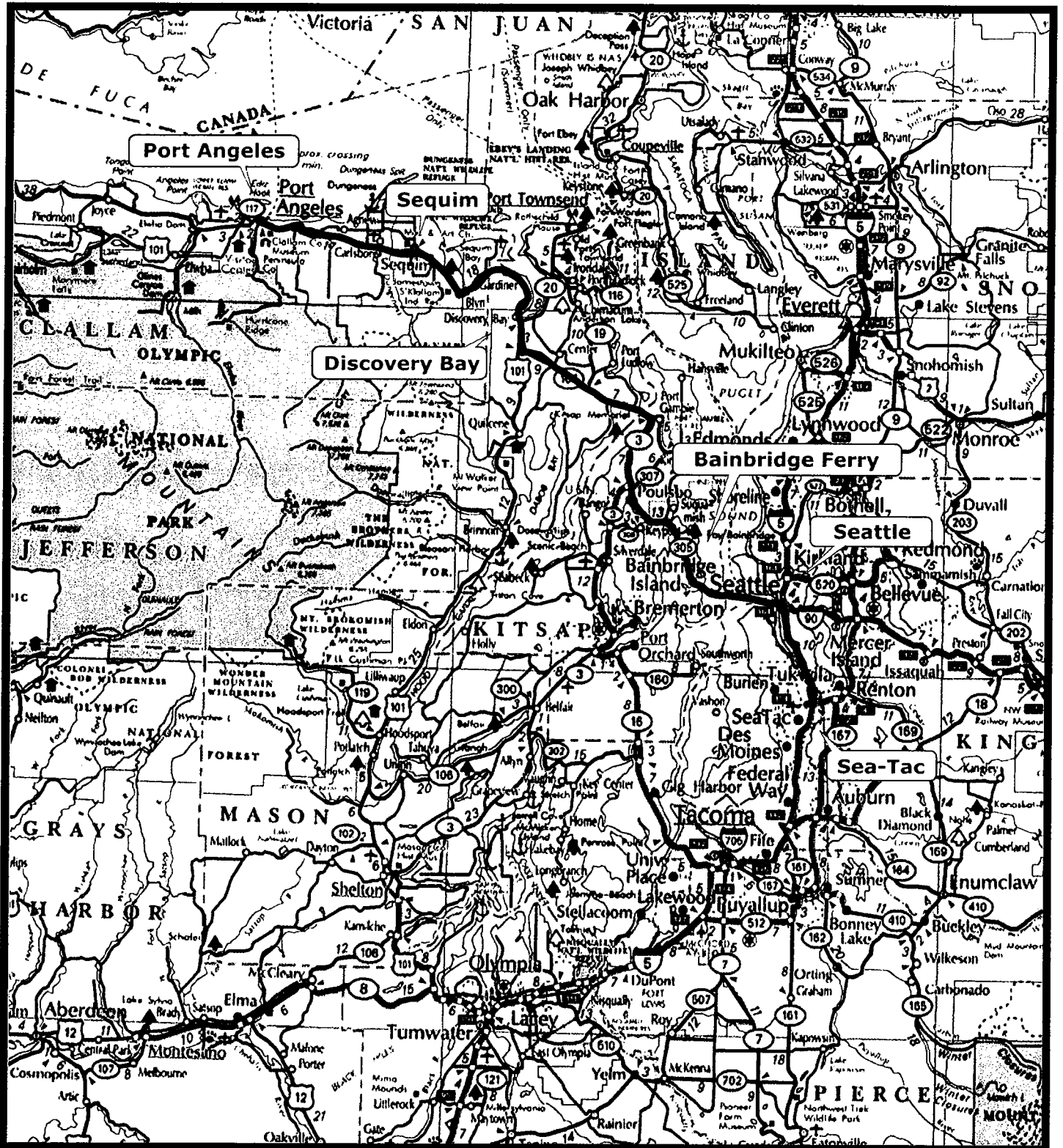
OLYMPIC BUS LINES

REGULAR ROUTE No. 1



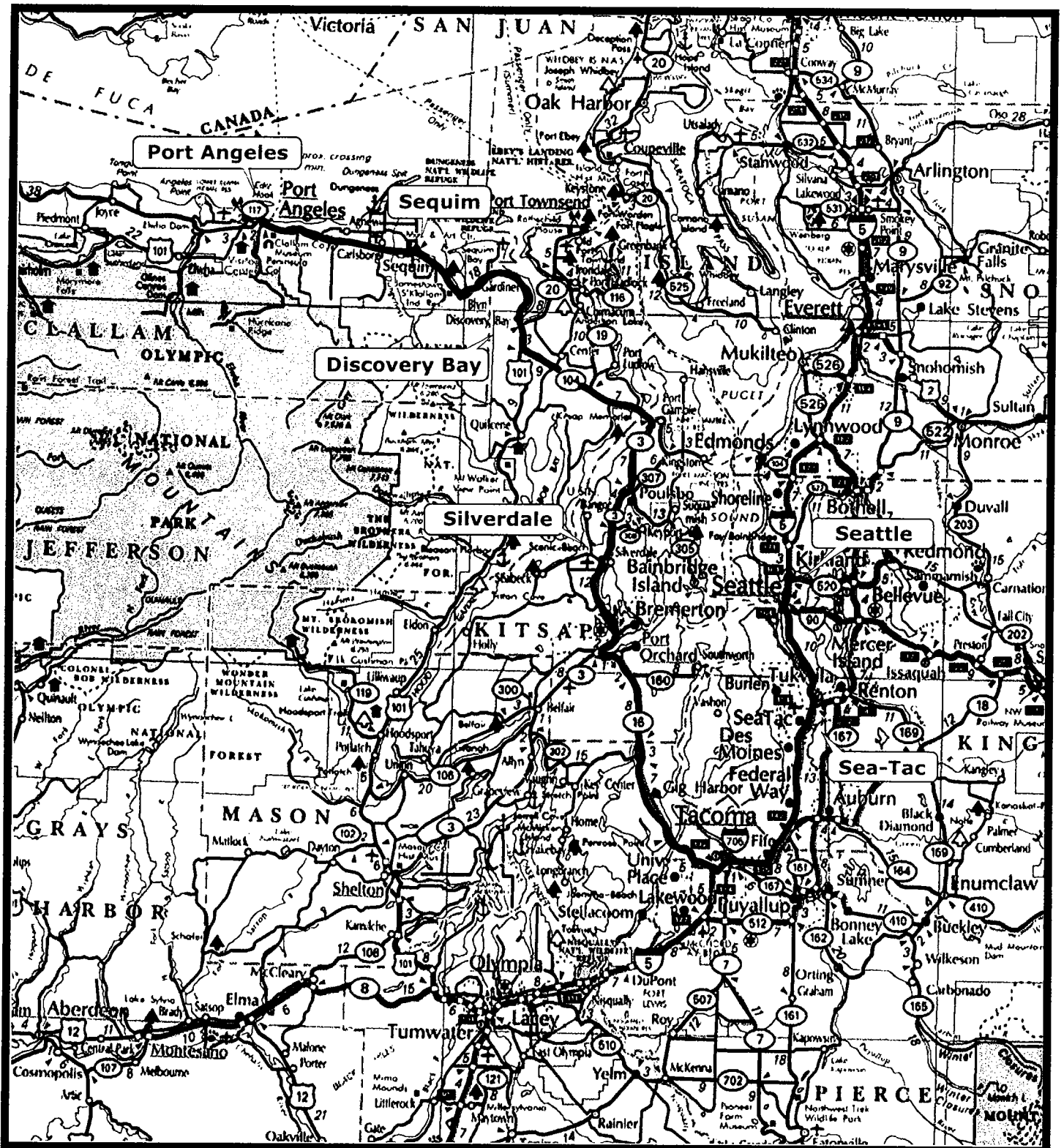
OLYMPIC BUS LINES

ALTERNATE ROUTE No. 1



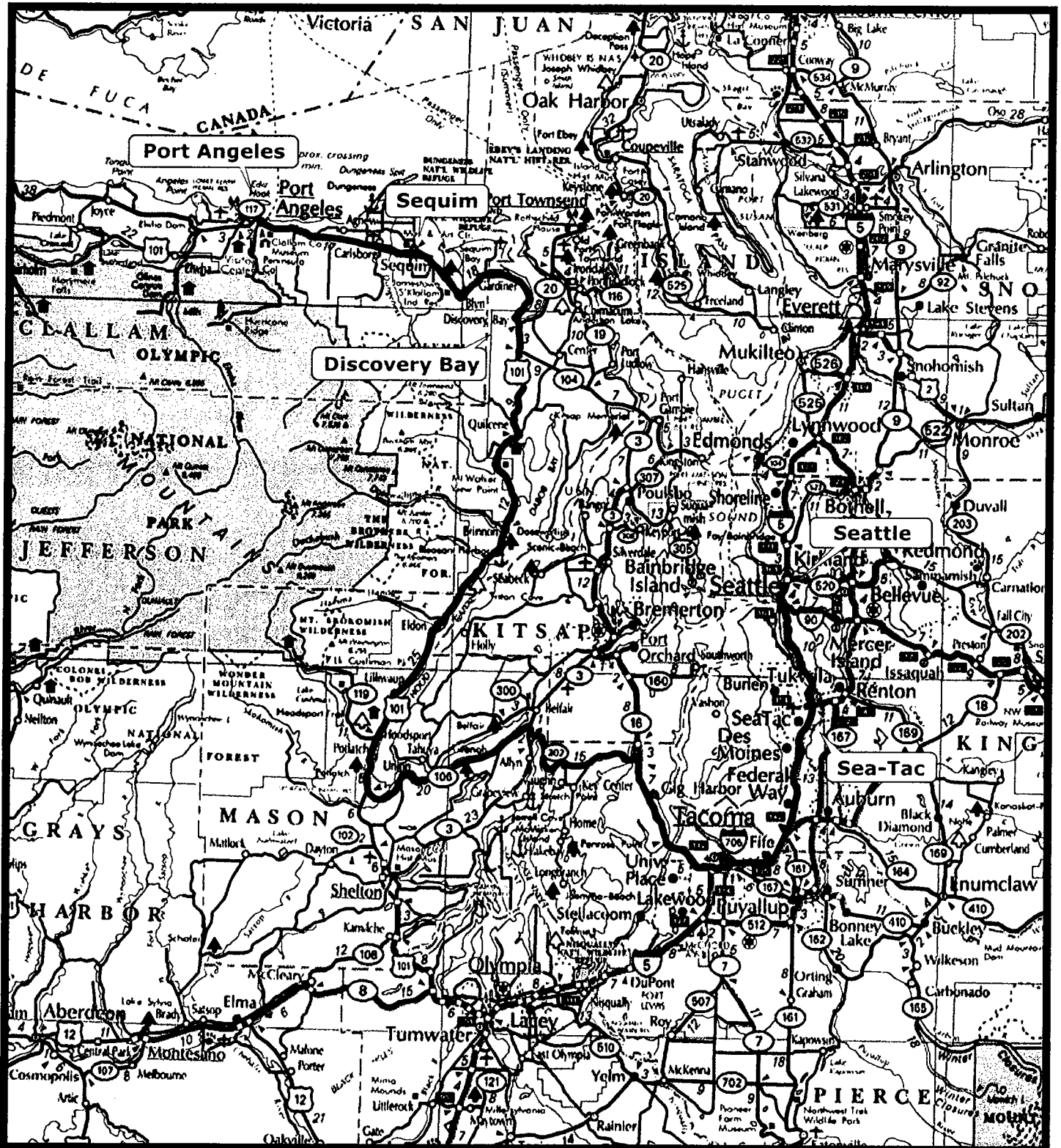
OLYMPIC BUS LINES

ATTACHMENT 11

This filing includes the following:

1. Removal of Port Townsend from our existing territory. This is due to our inability to properly service this area with our existing staff and equipment. We are adding a stop at Discovery Bay (which actually has a Port Townsend address), which is along our normal route to Seattle in order to service the needs of Port Townsend passengers.
2. Addition of Discovery Bay as a stop along our existing route.
3. Addition of Kingston as a stop along our existing route.
4. Addition of Edmonds as a stop along our existing route.
5. Addition of Silverdale as a stop along our existing route.

There will be no service between Seattle and SeaTac Airport, and there will be no service between Silverdale and Seattle.

Discovery Bay, Kingston, and Edmonds were actually shown as flag stops on our previous tariff (Tariff No. 9), and we have been servicing these areas since we purchased our original Certificate C 992. Silverdale was also on a previous tariff until we temporarily discontinued the route. It was only recently pointed out to us by staff that these flag stops were not on our Certificate C 992. We have worked with staff in "cleaning up" our existing tariff and instructed to reapply for these stops on a new application. Although these are only small areas of service, Discovery Bay, Kingston, and Edmonds are integral links between these areas and Seattle, as we are the only scheduled bus service along these routes. With Silverdale growing rapidly in population, we see passenger needs for shopping, and medical appointments between Port Angeles and Silverdale. Since Silverdale is along one of our existing routes, it is easily serviced with very little interruption to our existing service.
