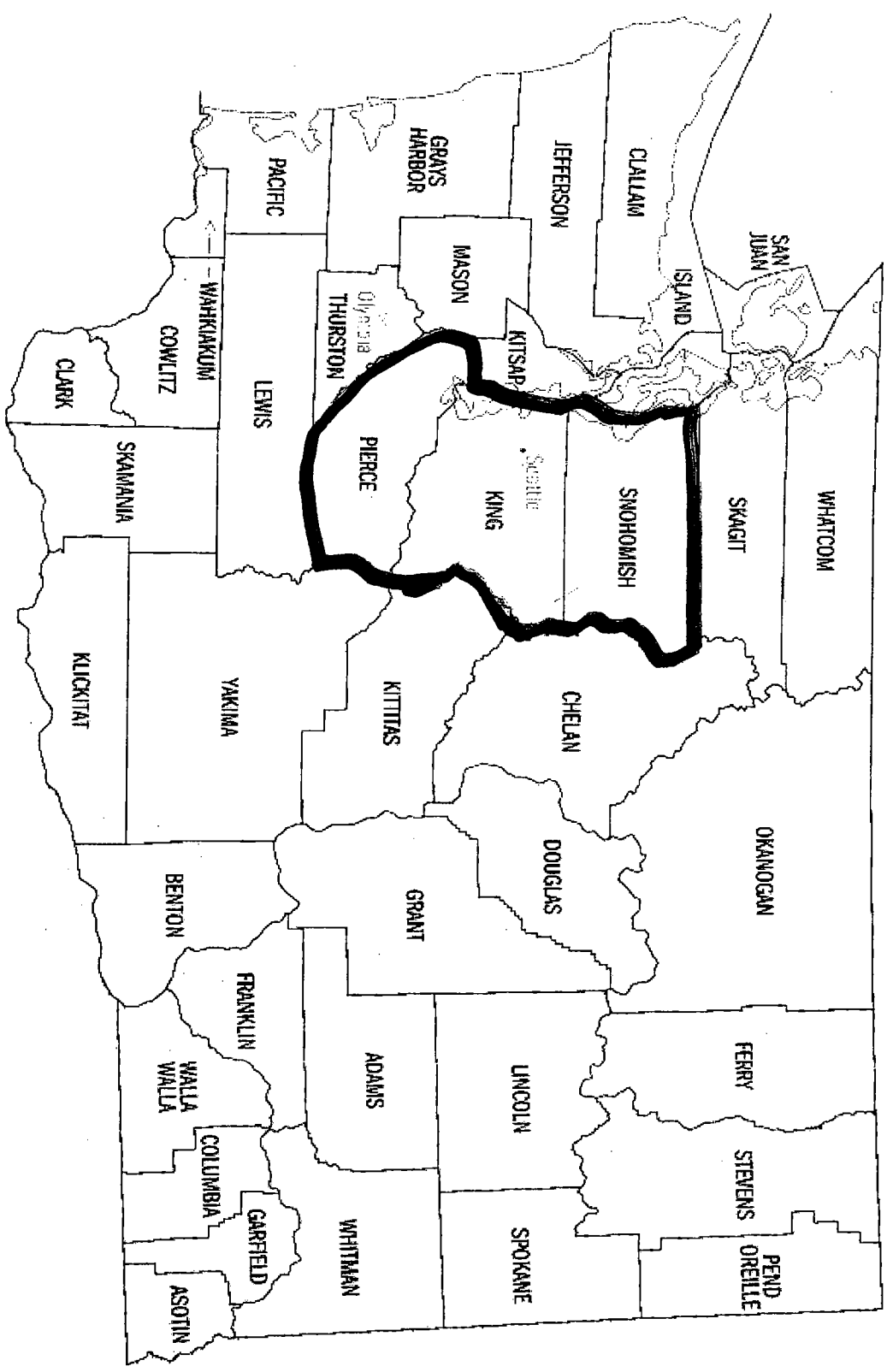

I could not manage to get a state subcontract, nor a private contract despite all my efforts since January 2003. I

Because of the lack of opportunities in the contracting and wireless sector in Seattle, I have made the decision to venture myself in a service oriented business where the decision of failure or success is made by the general public.

This is also the only business where I think I will have the opportunity to help promote clean transportation energy. My company Green ride transportation will work toward improving fuel efficiency in vehicle and promote the use of safe fuel from alternative energy.

There are very few transporter services in the Seattle area and adding another one will provide a benefit to customers in Washington. The market could sustain the additional competition.
