The purpose of this tariff revision is to implement the following tax change:

Ordinance 6326 documents that the additional tax was approved in the September, 2004 primary election and establishes an effective date for the tax of December 1, 2004.

The Company respectfully requests that the Commission allow this tariff change to become effective on December 1, 2004, with less than statutory notice (LSN) in order to pass through the change in rates coincident with the effective date established by Ordinance 6326. Information required by WAC 480-80-122 is contained throughout this letter. Karl R. Karzmar is authorized to issue tariff changes on behalf of PSE.

The tariff sheet described herein reflects an issue date of November 10, 2004, and an effective date of December 11, 2004.
