**Our customer surveys indicate there are a number of customers who desire to be dropped off at hotels and motels adjacent to SeaTac Airport. This has been requested primarily for the evening shuttles when customers will be spending the night at SeaTac Airport area hotels and motels in order to catch next day early morning flights.**

**Currently customers who may want to stay at SeaTac area hotels or motels have to exit the Airporter Shuttle vehicles at the SeaTac departure level, then transfer themselves and their luggage to the hotel shuttle bus loading area, currently located in the SeaTac Airport parking garage, then wait for a specific hotel/motel shuttle to transport them to their hotel or motel.**

**This service would be provided to those customers who desired to be delivered to a specific hotel/motel only after delivery of scheduled passengers to SeaTac Airport. In most cases, hotels and motels adjacent to SeaTac are on the way to the holding lot used by our drivers while waiting for the scheduled departure time on the return trip.**

**The company does not anticipate requests for delivery to more than one or two hotels/motels per trip.**

**No service may be rendered between SeaTac International Airport on the one hand and any point within a 3 mile radius of SeaTac International Airport.**
