

- n. The 1996 International truck, the 1993 Kenworth truck, and the 1992 Peterbuilt truck, together with any trailers or other rolling stock leased to either corporation and owned by the parties individually.
- o. Shareholder note receivable owed to the parties from personal loans made to the corporations awarded to the wife herein.

3.4 PURCHASE OF BUSINESS ASSETS AND EQUIPMENT FROM HUSBAND BY WIFE:

The wife is purchasing the husband's interest in certain business assets, specifically corporate stock, commercial real estate, and revenue producing equipment. The following provisions set forth the agreement between the parties for the wife's purchase of the husband's interest in the business assets:

- 1. The total purchase price is \$380,000. The wife has made two previous payments of \$5,000 each, reducing the current principle balance to \$374,417.10 as of 4-1-04. The wife shall pay \$300,000 or more within 15 days of the entry of the decree of dissolution herein, or the maximum available financing through Whidby Island Bank, if less than \$300,000.
- The balance shall be paid within 24 months of the entry of the decree or upon sale of the Goldenrod property (see paragraph 3.5 herein) whichever occurs sooner with no prepayment penalty for earlier payment in full.

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- In consideration of the payment from the wife to the husband, the husband covenants and warrants that he will not own or operate or otherwise engage in a moving and storage or long distance trucking business within the State of Washington for a period of five years from the entry of the decree of dissolution herein. In the event litigation ensues over enforcement of said covenant and a court finds the covenant is unreasonable as to time or geographic area, then the covenant shall be modified so that it is enforceable and reasonable with a corresponding reduction in the purchase price allocated to the covenant not to compete. The husband has stipulated and agreed that the geographic area of the covenant and the duration of the covenant is reasonable inasmuch as the company engages in competitive bidding of jobs state wide. The husband has represented that he plans to own and operate a truck and trailer as an independent truck driver, and the parties agree that this covenant shall not preclude him from owning and operating a single truck and trailer as an independent long-haul truck driver. A supplemental document setting forth in more detail the terms and conditions of this covenant not to compete shall be prepared along with other documents reflecting the stock redemption, the transfer of the real property, and other terms of the purchase and sale of the business assets if necessary.
- 4. The wife has previously made two payments of \$5,000 each for the months of February and March, and she shall receive credit for those payments against the total price of the transaction, taking into account the amortization of the \$380,000 obligation at 7% simple interest. In the event the wife is unable to secure financing in order to make the initial lump sum payment to the husband as set forth in paragraph 3.4 (1) herein by April 1, 2004, then she shall make an additional payment of \$5,000 with allocation between principle and interest on the remaining balance of \$374,417.10 at 7% simple interest for each month the lump sum remains unpaid.
- 5. The unpaid balance shall bear interest at the rate of 7% per annum, simple interest.
- 6. The wife shall make interest only payments to the husband until the remaining balance is paid in full. Interest only payments shall be made on or before the 5th of each month, and a late payment of \$25 dollars if more than 10 days late. Any periodic payment from the wife to the husband required under the terms of this agreement shall be made by direct deposit from the wife into a

bank account designated by the husband as soon as said direct deposit can be established.

- 7. The unpaid balance shall be secured by a promissory note and deed of trust against the wife's ½ interest in the Goldenrod property being sold under the terms of this decree.
- 8. The husband shall receive his regular salary for the period of January 15 to 31st, which paycheck should have been received on February 15th, said payment to be made on or before April 30th, 2004.
- 9. The husband shall be reimbursed for his cell phone bill for the month of December in the amount of \$\$224.23 by Northwest Moving Services, Inc. on or before April 30th, 2004.
- 10. The Husband shall be responsible for his own cell phone charges on the company cell phone after February 1, 2004. The Husband's obligation for cell phone charges have already been reimbursed to the company for billings received in February and March 2004. Husband is in the process of transferring his cell phone number from the company plan to an individual plan he is setting up. As soon as the cell phone number is transferred to the new plan, Husband shall return the cell phone and accessories to the company.
- 11. The purchase price shall be allocated as follows:
 - 1. \$19,217 is allocated to the purchase of Revenue Equipment
 - 2. \$119,979 is allocated to the purchase of the Warehouse located at 1261 Bouslog Road.
 - 3. \$50,000 is allocated to the redemption of the husband's common stock in Chinook Moving and Storage, Inc. by the corporation.
 - 4. \$75,000 is allocated to the redemption of the husband's common stock in Northwest Moving Services, Inc. by the corporation.
 - 5. \$37,521 is allocated to the purchase of the husband's interest in the stockholder loans receivable.
 - 6. \$50,000 is allocated to the covenant not to compete to be signed by the husband as agreed by the parties.
- 3.5 The following property shall continue to be owned by the parties as tenants in common and shall be sold:

- 2. All lands lying East of the Goldenrod Road.
- 3. That portion lying within that parcel as conveyed for right-of-way purposes by deeds recorded Ma 27, 1976, under Auditor's File Nos. 835797 and 835798, records of Skagit County, Washington.

Situated in Skagit County, Washington.

Tax parcel #P107423

Commencing April 1, 2004, pending sale of the property, each party shall be responsible for 50% of the monthly mortgage payments on said property and 50% of the real estate taxes on said property. The husband shall make his 50% payment directly to the wife, and she shall make the actual mortgage payment. Each party's 50% share of the mortgage payments shall be made timely, and if any payment is more than 10 days late, a late penalty of \$25 shall be paid by the late paying party in addition to all of any late payment penalty assessed by the mortgage holder.

In the event the wife is unable to obtain bank financing to make the lump sum payment to the husband by the time the April 2004 payment is due on the Goldenrod property, the wife shall make the entire payment and be reimbursed by the husband for his 50% of said payment within 10 days of his receipt of said lump sum payment. No late penalty for the husband shall be assessed as to Goldenrod payments accruing prior to his receipt of the initial lump sum payment from the wife as required under paragraph 3.4 herein.

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The property shall remain continuously listed for sale at a price agreed upon by the parties. The parties shall accept any reasonable offer for the property and shall cooperate in the listing and marketing of the property.

If a dispute arises as to what constitutes a reasonable offer for the purchase of said property, the dispute shall be arbitrated with George McIntosh. The decision of the arbitrator shall be binding on the parties. The net proceeds shall be divided equally between the parties

3.4 LIABILITIES TO BE PAID BY THE HUSBAND.

The husband shall pay the following community or separate liabilities:

- a. The outstanding obligation owed to Principal Residential Mortgage Inc. on the real property located on Allen West Road and awarded to the husband above.
- b. The outstanding obligation owed to Whidbey Island Bank for the 2000 Ford F350 awarded to him above.
- c. The outstanding obligation owed to Key Bank for the Winnebago awarded to him above.
- d. Any outstanding obligation on his personal line of credit to U.S.Bank.
- e. Any credit cards in his name.
- f. 50% of any expenses incurred or owed on the Goldenrod Road property located in Burlington, WA, and continuing to be owned by the parties as tenants in common, including but not limited to the monthly mortgage payments and 50% of the real estate taxes. See paragraph 3.5 for further clarification of this obligation.

Unless otherwise provided herein, the husband shall pay all liabilities incurred by him since the date of separation.

3.5 LIABILITIES TO BE PAID BY THE WIFE.

The wife shall pay the following community or separate liabilities:

- g. All original documents relating to any property, real or personal, awarded to either party herein shall be provided to the party to whom the property is awarded if in the possession of the other party.
