- c. Why does the public safety require the installation of the proposed automatic signals, gates or other warning devices? A diagnostic team review of the crossing in 2003 resulted in a recommendation to upgrade the warning devices as proposed.

- **5. Funding**: What is the funding source for the proposed installation? <u>Federal Grade Crossing Hazard Elimination Grant Section 130</u>
- **6. Diagrams**: A diagram showing the crossing and the location of the components of the proposed system is attached.




