METHOD OF FINANCE

This transfer was part of a consolidation and therefore no sale of assets occurred.

DEREGULATION IS IN THE PUBLIC INTEREST

- The benefits of this transfer of assets through this deregulation include expanded financial resources, additional staffing and service equipment and water quality staff to provide all aspects of water system repair and operations. The former owner of Tall Timber Water Systems, LLC no longer desires to own and operate this public water system independent of other similar companies who seek deregulation, also now owned by the same individual. Customers were notified of the sale and transfer.
- As a result of the prior sale and transfer of assets, the subsequent filing and Commission approval of rates to establish parity of water rates, H&R Waterworks, Inc. has demonstrated that deregulation is in the public interest.


