Subject: VERIZON REQUEST FOR ONE 10,000 NUMBER CODE

Dear Ms. Washburn:

Verizon Northwest Inc. (Verizon) requests the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission to direct the Pooling Administrator (PA) to provide Verizon with one ten thousand number code to satisfy the requirement for additional numbers for Microsoft Corporation in Redmond, WA.

The customer plans to open four (4) new building in the next three (3) months and five (5) new buildings within the next year at their Redmond Campus area. The growth they are experiencing is consuming their current number blocks at a rapid rate. They currently forecast to be out of Direct Inward Dialing (DID) numbers within the next 35 days. Microsoft needs an exchange code that conforms to 425-xx1 to meet the requirements of its 5-digit dialing plan. This request is made because the serving central office does not meet the “months to exhaust” requirement of the PA. The PA will only accept 6 months or less to exhaust without a waiver request from the Commission.

The Washington Commission has the authority to review the PA’s criteria and request a waiver when appropriate, in this case a waiver request for the months to exhaust criteria. Verizon


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requests the Commission instruct the PA to release the numbering resources necessary to meet the needs of this Verizon customer.

Verizon requests approval of this request with an effective date of March 26, 2006. The Commission's waiver request must be submitted with the company's application to PA for the numbering resources needed for deployment of service to this customer. Please find attached a copy of the company's Block Application Form to the PA and a copy of the letter from the customer requesting the number blocks.

Dear Sir:

Microsoft Corporation is continuing to grow our Redmond Campus area; we anticipate opening 4 new buildings in the next 3 months and 5 new buildings in the next year. The rapid growth we are experiencing is consuming our current number blocks at an alarming rate. We are currently forecasting to be out of DID numbers in 35 Days.

Microsoft needs an exchange code that conforms to 425-xx1 to meet the requirements of its 5-digit dialing plan. Today, 425-xx0 is restricted (used for operator access on campus), 425-xx2, 425-xx3, 425-xx4, 425-xx5, 425-xx6, 425-xx7 and 425-xx8 are already in use, and 425-xx9 is restricted (for dialing off campus)

Microsoft's preferences for the new exchange code are 425-701 (first choice) or 425-721 (second choice) because those codes are adjacent to Microsoft's existing DID number blocks.

As you can see this is an urgent matter, your attention to this issue is appreciated.
