Children under two years of age occupying a seat and children under the age of thirteen will be charged one-half of the adult fare, adding sufficient cents to make the fare end in "0" or "5".

INTERMEDIATE APPLICATION: Fares to or from intermediate points named herein, will be the same as the fare to or from the next more distant station for which fares are named.

ROUND TRIP FARES: Except as otherwise provided, round trip fares will be 100% of the one-way fare, adding sufficient cents to make the fare end in "0" or "5".

TICKET LIMITATION: One-way tickets will be good for six months from date of sale. Round trip tickets will be good for six months from date of sale.

STOP-OVERS: Stop-overs will be allowed at any point on the route within the limit of the ticket upon notice when ticket is purchased.

TICKET REDEMPTION: Unused tickets or portions will be redeemed when presented by the owner as follows: Round trip within six months of date of sale. One way within six months of date of sale. Unused portions of tickets will be redeemed by charging the regular fare for the portions used and refunding the balance of the purchase price. Commuter tickets will be redeemed by charging the cheapest fare applicable to the purchase price.


