We have worked with Deborah Reynolds, Gene Eckhardt, and most recently Rey Dejos of WUTC staff on the GIS Solid Waste Mapping project.

This letter was requested to confirm the text and request certificate re-statement.

PID119 (enclosed) states " G000089 Solid Waste Collection Service in Yakima County and in the City of Yakima. (this certificate does not authorize the duplication of any service undertaken by the City of Yakima or contracted for by it).

This text accurately describes our service area, Yakima County. The City of Yakima operates it's own solid waste and yardwaste collection services for residential accounts only. We provide commercial service to all commercial accounts in Yakima, as well as residential curbside recycling. When the City of Yakima annexes an area, they issue an exclusive seven year franchise to us for all solid waste collection in the annexed area. At some point following the franchise expiration, the City of Yakima begins serving the residential solid waste and yardwaste accounts, and leaves the commercial solid waste and residential curbside recycling accounts to us to serve.
