PETITION OF PACIFICORP FOR ACCOUNTING ORDER	

Pursuant to Order No. 1 in Docket UE-031658 governing the accounting treatment of environmental expenditures, PacifiCorp d/b/a Pacific Power & Light ("PacifiCorp" or "the Company"), petitions the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission ("Commission") for an accounting order authorizing the Company to begin deferral of the estimated expense for environmental remediation work at the Utah Metals site, effective as of the filing date of this petition. In support of this petition, PacifiCorp states:

- 1. PacifiCorp is an electrical company and public service company in the state of Washington pursuant to RCW 80.04.010 and is subject to the jurisdiction of the Commission with regard to its rates, service and accounting practices. PacifiCorp also provides retail electricity service in the states of Oregon, California, Idaho, Utah, and Wyoming. PacifiCorp's address is: 825 NE Multnomah, Portland, Oregon 97232.
- 2. This petition is filed pursuant to RCW 80.01.040(3), which authorizes the Commission to regulate in the public interest the rates, service, facilities, and practices of electrical companies; RCW 80.040.090 which authorizes the Commission to prescribe the forms of accounts to be kept by public service companies; and WAC 480-100-203, pertaining to the accounting requirements applicable to electric utilities in the state of Washington.

- 4. The Company anticipates that expenses of approximately \$3.5 million will be incurred on a total company basis for environmental remediation costs related to the Utah Metals and Union Pacific Railroad property. As the timing of the remediation work is uncertain, the Company is only seeking an accounting order authorizing deferral of these expenses and does not request a determination of ratemaking treatment at this time and instead proposes to address amortization and recovery of these costs in a future ratemaking proceeding. Pursuant to Order No. 01, Docket No. UE-031658, the level of environmental remediation costs allocable to Washington and subject to the requested accounting treatment shall be consistent with the interjurisdictional cost allocation methodology then in effect for the Company.
- 5. The Utah Metals facility is a metals salvage yard located in Salt Lake City, Utah and is a third party provider of decommissioning and salvage services. The East end of the

facility is owned by Union Pacific Railroad from whom Utah Metals leases the land. From

approximately 1956 through 1984, Utah Power sent transformers to the site for decommissioning

and salvage. During the decommissioning of the transformers, PCB oil contaminated the

concrete at the Utah Metals facility and the soil on Union Pacific Railroad property. These

contaminated areas are on the Environmental Protection Agency's ("EPA") National Priorities

List and were investigated by the State of Utah under contract with EPA in February 2006. Utah

Metals continues to operate the metals salvage operations on their property and plans to for the

foreseeable future.

6. PacifiCorp proposes to account for the regulatory asset by debiting Account

182.3, Other Regulatory Assets, and crediting Account 253, Other Deferred Credits. The

requested accounting treatment has no impact to rate base used to determine revenue

requirement.

PacifiCorp submits that it incurs environmental remediation expenses as a 7.

legitimate cost of operating as a public utility in the state of Washington. These costs relate to the

Company's environmental remediation program activities and are generally undertaken to fulfill

obligations imposed by state and federal environmental agencies.

WHEREFORE, PacifiCorp respectfully requests an order of the Commission authorizing

it to establish and defer its costs related to the Utah Metals site environmental remediation

program.
