Subject: VERIZON REQUEST FOR A TEN THOUSAND NUMBER CODE

Dear Ms. Washburn:

Verizon Northwest Inc. (Verizon) requests the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission to direct the Pooling Administrator (PA) to provide Verizon with one ten thousand number code to satisfy the requirement for additional numbers from T-Mobile located in Bothell, WA in the Bothell Rate Center, NPA 425, LATA 674, OCN 4324.

The customer requests one ten thousand number code for use at their Nexus Data Center to support their growing number of conference bridge users and increase in employees. This location has been selected for the customer's centralized Voice over IP PBX System. The customer has requested that the prefix 666 not be used in the new code.

This waiver request is made because Verizon's request for one ten thousand number code was denied because the serving central office does not meet the "months to exhaust" requirement of the PA. The PA will only accept 6 months or less to exhaust without a waiver request from the Commission. This Rate Center is currently at 28.3 months to exhaust.

The Washington Commission has the authority to review the PA's criteria and request a waiver when appropriate, in this case a waiver request for the months to exhaust criteria. Verizon requests the Commission instruct the PA to release the numbering resources necessary to meet the needs of this Verizon customer.

Verizon requests approval of this request with an effective date of December 30, 2006. The Commission's waiver request must be submitted with the company's application to the PA for the numbering resources needed for deployment of service to this customer.

Please find attached a copy of the company's Block Application Form (Part 1A) to the PA, Neustar's Months to Exhaust and Utilization Certification Worksheet, the denial from the Pooling Administration System (PAS), and a copy of the letter from the customer requesting the number code.


