Subject: **REQUEST FOR A TEN THOUSAND NUMBER CODE**

Dear Ms. Washburn:

Verizon Northwest Inc. (Verizon) requests the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission to direct the Pooling Administrator (PA) to provide Verizon with one ten thousand number code to satisfy the requirement for additional numbers from The Tulalip Tribes located in Marysville, WA in the Marysville Rate Center, NPA 360, LATA 674, OCN 4324.

The customer requests one ten thousand number code to support the addition of a new luxury hotel and the ongoing build-out of retail stores, data centers, casinos, and tribal residences. The customer's intent is to begin a new "tribal wide" numbering plan immediately with the new prefix to sustain rapid growth and scheduled projects.

The customer will return the 4,300 numbers currently in use by means of a migration which should take no longer than twelve (12) months. Currently, the Marysville, WA exchange is at an extreme exhaust of numbers. The customer is only able to obtain contiguous ranges of 20 numbers or less with the existing prefixes which are not sufficient to support the customer's existing numbering plan and large infrastructure projects. The only restriction the customer has placed on the request for the ten thousand number code is that it not contain the 666 prefix.

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This waiver request is made because Verizon's request for one ten thousand number code was denied by the PA because the serving central office does not meet the "months to exhaust" criteria. The PA requires the "months to exhaust" be less than or equal to six (6) months and the serving central office is currently at 37 months. Also, the percent utilization is currently at 72%, which is less than the 75% utilization required by the FCC.


The Washington Commission has the authority to review the PA's criteria and request a waiver when appropriate, in this case a waiver request for the utilization criteria. Verizon requests the commission instruct the PA to release the numbering resources necessary to meet the needs of this Verizon customer.

Verizon requests approval of this waiver request with an effective date of March 29, 2007. The Commission's waiver request must be submitted with the company's application to the PA for the numbering resources needed for deployment of service to this customer.

Please find attached a copy of the company's Block Application Form (Part 1) to the PA, Appendix B Months to Exhaust Certification Worksheet, the denial from the Neustar Pooling Administration System (PAS), and a copy of the letter from the customer requesting the number code.

Re: Request for a new Tulalip Tribes prefix

Tulalip Data Services is requesting that Verizon obtain a new prefix (10,000 DID's) for The Tulalip Tribes as soon as possible out of the Marysville, Washington exchange (ACO = A45). We are currently using 4300 DID numbers and expect the need for an additional 4,000 to 6,000 DID numbers over the next several years. The Tulalip Tribes is embarking on an aggressive business expansion plan. This plan will require large new number ranges in the near future. Tulalip Data Services intends to begin a new numbering plan immediately with the new prefix to sustain the rapid growth and projects on our schedule. We will return the 4300 DID's currently in use by means of a migration which we anticipate will take no longer than 12 months.

Currently the Marysville, Washington exchange has very few new numbers available and cannot provide the contiguous blocks that we require to support our existing numbering plan and business needs. At this time we are only able to obtain contiguous ranges of 20 numbers or less within the existing prefixes. Please begin the process to secure a new prefix for The Tulalip Tribes and provide a time line as to when it will be available.
