Subject: **REQUEST FOR THREE ONE THOUSAND NUMBER BLOCKS**

Dear Ms. Washburn:

Verizon Northwest Inc. (Verizon) requests the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission to direct the Pooling Administrator (PA) to provide Verizon with three one thousand number blocks to satisfy the requirement for additional numbers from Skagit Valley Hospital located in Mount Vernon, WA in the Mount Vernon Rate Center, NPA 360, LATA 674, OCN 4423.

The customer requests three one thousand number blocks in the 1,000, 2,000 and 3,000 sequence to support the expansion of the hospital campus which includes a Regional Cancer Care Center with 20,000 square feet and 29 employees, and hospital patient care expansion in a facility with 220,000 square feet. The hospital includes 142 patient rooms on 3 floors, 25 exam rooms designated for trauma emergency services, 6 operating rooms, 19 day surgery rooms, 12 recovery rooms, 1 treatment room, pharmacy services and various patient support areas. There will be approximately 550 employees to support the campus expansion. There will be a significant increase in fax lines. The Skagit Hospice facility, with 6,000 square feet and approximately 52 employees will be relocated as well. The customer's occupancy date for the hospital expansion is May 25, 2007.

The Mount Vernon Rate Center does not have the consecutive numbers the customer is requesting.

This waiver request is made because Verizon's request for three one thousand number blocks was denied by the PA because the serving central office does not meet the "months to exhaust" criteria. The PA requires the "months to exhaust" be less than or equal to six (6) months and the serving central office is currently at 61 months. Also, the percent utilization is currently at 66%, which is less than the 75% utilization required by the FCC.


The Washington Commission has the authority to review the PA's criteria and request a waiver when appropriate, in this case a waiver request for the utilization criteria. Verizon requests the commission instruct the PA to release the numbering resources necessary to meet the needs of this Verizon customer.

Verizon requests approval of this waiver request with an effective date of April 21, 2007. The Commission's waiver request must be submitted with the company's application to the PA for the numbering resources needed for deployment of service to this customer.

Please find attached a copy of the company's Block Application Form (Part 1) to the PA, Appendix B Months to Exhaust Certification Worksheet, the denial from the Neustar Pooling Administration System (PAS), and a copy of the letter from the customer requesting the number blocks.

Instructions for filling out each Section of the Part 1A form:

Section 1.1 Contact information requires that Service Providers supply under "Block Applicant" the company name, company headquarters address, a contact within the company, an address where the contact person may be reached, in addition to the correct phone, fax, and e-mail address. The Pooling Administrator section also requires the Service Provider to fill in the Pooling Administrator's name, address, phone, fax and e-mail.

Section 1.2 Service Providers who need a thousands-block assignment or for an Location Routing Number (LRN) are required to fill in this section. If needed for an LRN, a CO Code Application needs to also be submitted to the PA. The Service Provider should supply the Numbering Plan Area (NPA); the Local Access Transport Area (LATA), which is a three-digit number that can be found in the Telcordia™ LERG™ Routing Guide. The Operating Company Number (OCN) assigned to the service provider and the OCN its parent company. An OCN is a four-character alphanumeric assigned by Telcordia™ Routing Administration (TRA). To Whom It May Concern:

Skagit Valley Hospital in Mount Vernon, Washington is building an expansion to the existing hospital. Skagit Valley Hospital is a 137-bed hospital with 1,100 employees and serves Skagit County and portions of Island, North Snohomish and San Juan Counties. The new hospital expansion will be dedicated primarily to patient care areas. As such, we will require the addition of several new telephone numbers. Skagit Valley Hospital has made a request for 3000 new telephone numbers from our local carrier, Verizon, for a dialing plan that is straightforward for our patients and our community. The numbers requested were in the 1,000, 2,000 and 3,000 line numbers. We have been advised that at this time the Mount Vernon Central Office does not have a block of 3,000 numbers available, and Verizon has advised us to request a new prefix in order to get the numbers we would need for our dialing plan.

Therefore, Skagit Valley Hospital would like to request a new prefix to accommodate the block of 3,000 numbers in the 1,000, 2,000 and 3,000 sequence, together with an expiated waiver review process. The hospital does have dialing restrictions with numbers beginning in "Zero, 6, 7, 8, or 9, however they are outside of the blocks of numbers we are requesting. The hospital has an occupancy date of May 25, 2007 when the new numbers would be placed into service.

Thank you for your earliest consideration to this request. Please let us know as soon as possible when the new prefix can be activated.
