Subject: WAC 480-93-020 Proximity Considerations – Request for Approval

Dear Mr. Lykken:

We request approval to install a segment of pipe operating at 499 psig within 100 feet of a building intended for human occupancy. The segment is a service line to 77 E Bucktail View, in Belfair.

The customer's home is located adjacent to our easement for the 8" Kitsap Peninsula Transmission Line. That line has an MAOP of 499 psig. We will be adding a 30 foot segment of 34" high pressure service line to reach a high pressure service regulator that will reduce the pressure to below 60 psig. From there, 50 feet of 5/8" PE service line will be installed. I have attached a sketch of the proposed service line for your review. The customer approved this location. It is away from roads and driveways.

Please notify us of your progress on this request. Our customer is anxious to receive service.
