- 1. Pursuant to WAC 480-100-008 and WAC 480-07-110(1), PacifiCorp, dba Pacific Power & Light ("PacifiCorp"), hereby petitions the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission ("Commission") for a modification of the Actual Results for Washington Operations Report filing requirements contained in WAC 480-100-275.

3. WAC 480-100-275 requires electric utilities to file actual results of Washington operations within sixty days of the end of each quarter. PacifiCorp filed its first quarter 2007 report on March 31, 2007 and was scheduled to file its report for the quarter ending June 30, 2007 on August 29, 2007. On June 21, 2007, the Commission issued Order No. 8 in Docket No. UE-061546, approving PacifiCorp's Western Control Area interjurisdictional cost allocation methodology, with modifications. To accurately implement

the new allocation methodology, PacifiCorp requests additional time to report actual results for the second quarter.

- 4. The Commission may grant a modification of its rules "if consistent with the public interest, the purposes underlying the regulation, and applicable statutes." WAC 480-07-110(1). PacifiCorp's petition meets these standards. The public interest and the purposes underlying the quarterly reporting requirements will be best served by using the most up-to-date and recently-approved allocation methodology.
- 5. PacifiCorp respectfully requests a thirty day extension of time in which to file its Actual Results for Washington Operations Report for the 2007 second quarter.
