1 The Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) previously gave you notice that your household goods permit listed above would be suspended if acceptable proof of liability and property damage insurance was not filed with this commission. Proof of insurance has not been received.

ORDER

2 Therefore, this order suspends your household goods permit and provisional operating authority for a period of 30 days effective October 8, 2007. As your permit is suspended, you are directed to cease all operations associated with this permit.

3 To avoid cancellation of your household goods permit and provisional operating authority and dismissal of your permanent authority application in Docket TV-071993, you must file acceptable proof of insurance or request a hearing within 30 days to show why the permit should not be canceled.

4 The Commissioners have delegated authority to the Executive Secretary to enter this Order under RCW 80.01.030 and WAC 480-07-905(d).

NOTICE TO PARTIES: This is an order delegated to the Executive Secretary for decision.
