

Notice for Intent to Establish a Railroad Quiet Zone Under 49 CFR 22.43

Ouiet Zone: Town of Steilacoom

This letter and the attachments are a Notice of Intent for the creation of a quiet zone. As required by the Federal Railroad Administration, the following information is provided to you and other parties.

All public highway-rail grade crossings to be included within the proposed quiet zone are:

Crossing ID Street Name Union Avenue 085755E

All pedestrian at grade crossings to be included within the proposed quiet zone are:

Street Name Crossing ID Public Park Access 085753R

The quiet zone is proposed to restrict the routine sounding of locomotive horns 24-hours a day.

The Town of Steilacoom's plan to implement a quiet zone at each crossing is:

Union Avenue: Install a Wayside Horn that complies with Appendix E to part 222-Requirements for Wayside Horns.

Pedestrian Crossing: Install new stop bars on both sides of the crossing for the Town Maintenance Vehicle access point, a Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD) approved "No Train Horn" sign on both sides of the crossing and finally "No Trespassing" signs installed to the fence of the Town Maintenance Vehicle access point. This installation will comply with the requirements of Appendix F to Part 222-Diagnostic Team Considerations.
