Petitioner requests the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission to enter an order disbursing funds from the Grade Crossing Protective Fund to pay for a highway-rail grade crossing safety improvement as follows:

1. Identifying information for the crossing:

Existing highway, street road, county: Stadium Way, Polouse County
 Existing railway: Washington & Idaho Railway

2. Description of current signals and/or gates at the crossing: Cantilever mounted 12 inch flashing lights with gates.

3. Type of current crossing circuitry: Motion Sensor

4. Project description and justification:

(a) Proposed changes: Install WSDOT provided 40 amp battery charger. Provide and install 20 amp charger. Replace all system batteries. Install power off indicator light.

(b) Justification for changes: Batteries and chargers have outlived life expectancy. Power off light indicates if commercial power is interrupted.

(c) Affects of proposed changes on warning devices and warning times for drivers: No change.

5. Drawings. Sketches drawn to scale are attached accurately showing the current and proposed layout of the highway (including shoulders, sidewalks, lanes of travel, bike lanes and crossing warning devices), of the crossing surface and of the railway in the vicinity of the crossing.


