Petitioner requests the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission to enter an order disbursing funds from the Grade Crossing Protective Fund to pay for a highway-rail grade crossing safety improvement as follows:

2. Description of current signals and/or gates at the crossing: Shoulder mounted 8 inch flashing lights.

3. Type of current crossing circuitry: AC/DC

4. Project description and justification:

(a) Proposed changes: Replace obsolete 8 inch flashing lights with 12 inch LED type. Install power off indicator light.

(b) Justification for changes: 8 inch lights are obsolete, 12 inch LED are industry standard. Power off light indicates if commercial power is interrupted.

(c) Affects of proposed changes on warning devices and warning times for drivers:
Enhanced visibility with LED flashing lights. No change in warning time.

5. Drawings. Sketches drawn to scale are attached accurately showing the current and proposed layout of the highway (including shoulders, sidewalks, lanes of travel, bike lanes and crossing warning devices), of the crossing surface and of the railway in the vicinity of the crossing. N/A
