As counsel for the carrier, I am submitting with this letter a completed and executed "Application for Charter and Excursion Carrier Service Certificate" on behalf of Brown's Crew Car of Wyoming, Inc. ("Brown's"), Lenexa, Kansas.

Please note that Brown's is currently engaged in interstate operations as a motor passenger carrier pursuant to appropriate Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration operating authority in its Docket MC-168832. In addition, Brown's has qualified to do business in Washington as a foreign corporation; a copy of the Certificate of Authority issued by the Secretary of State is also attached.


Applicant is aware of the Commission's requirement that vehicles to be used should be identified in the application and inspected prior to operation. At this point, Brown's is seeking operating authority in anticipation of future intrastate transportation in Washington. Although it has a substantial fleet of vehicles operating in other states in which it already conducts business, it does not now have vehicles in Washington. The carrier understands its obligation to have all vehicles to be used for intrastate transportation in Washington to be properly identified to and inspected by the Commission prior to their use.

I have included two checks payable to "WUTC," the first in the amount of \$200 as the filing fee for this application and the second in the amount of \$25 as payment of the minimum vehicle registration fee, even though it is not identifying a vehicle at this time.
