CR-101 (June 2004)

(Implements RCW 34.05.310)

Do NOT use for expedited rule making

WASHINGTON UTILITIES AND TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION Subject of possible rule making: Examine the need to revise WAC 480-31-080 Fees and annual report. The rulemaking has been assigned Docket TN-080875. Statutes authorizing the agency to adopt rules on this subject: RCW 80.01.040(4) and RCW 81.04.160 Reasons why rules on this subject may be needed and what they might accomplish: The Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) is exploring the need to remove the annual vehicle fee for non-profit transportation providers from rule and allow it to set the fee by order each year. This allows the Commission more flexibility in adjusting the fee, either up or down, to meet the intent of RCW 81.66.030, which requires the Commission to charge fees that approximate the cost of regulation.
