


Section 5 – Description of Closure

2. Describe the area currently served by the crossing, including the approximate number of homes or businesses that might be affected by the closure. This area is all industrial. The trucks will no longer have to stop at the crossing to wait for trains.
3. How far is the nearest alternate access across the tracks from the crossing proposed for closure? SR 167 freeway overpass 900' South and James Street at grade 3/4 mile South of 228th
4. Describe the alternate access route, including distance and driving time <u>James Street can be</u> used for alternate access during construction, which is 1.75 miles round trip. This will take
3.5 minutes if there are no stops at stoplights, 5 minutes with stoplights.
