This letter is a request for written authorization under WAC 480-93-020 for a proposed service at 40 E Dream Ln in Belfair WA located in our Bremerton District. Our customer has requested service to his garage.

A plan drawing of the proposed service is attached. This service will tap Cascade's 8 inch Kitsap High Pressure (HP) Line. This line has a maximum allowable operating pressure of 499 psig. The 8 inch line was constructed in 1963. A High Pressure Service Set (HPSS) will be installed at the customer's property line.

The garage is currently 55 feet from the center line of our 8 inch high pressure line. A ¾ inch steel service line will be extended 35 toward the building. A regulating device with an automatic shut off fracture disc (HPSS) will be installed at the above noted location, approximately 22 feet from the building, to reduce the pressure to 60 psig and protect from being over pressured. The inlet side of the service will also have a 499 psig MAOP up to the HPSS. The outlet side of the service line from the HPSS will be a PE 5/8 inch line with an MAOP of 60 psig. We will install a second regulator and a meter at the customer's building to provide residential pressures.

Please have Staff contact me at your earliest convenience so I may provide whatever additional information is needed. Our customer has requested service as soon as possible.
