1. Describe in detail why this crossing should have a wayside horn installed.

The Town of Steilacoom, WA is seeking to eliminate the routine sounding of the train horn at the Sunnyside pedestrian-rail grade crossing. Because the Sunnyside Pedestrian Crossing is not going to be part of a New 24 Hour Quiet Zone the crossing is not under the purview of the FRA Train Horn Rule. A diagnostic team review was conducted at the Sunnyside Pedestrian Crossing consisting of the BNSF Railway, Washington UTC and the Town of Steilacoom to discuss the possible treatments that could be employed to eliminate the routine sounding of the train horn. The diagnostic team concluded that the best treatment for the Sunnyside Pedestrian Crossing was the installation of wayside horns.
