Olympic Pipe Line Company hereby files tariff W.U.T.C. 32 to implement a decrease to its current intrastate transportation rates, and establish Bayview as a new origin point. The rates are set in accordance with the Olympic Settlement Methodology. That methodology is prescribed by the Amended Tariff Settlement Agreement which was reviewed and accepted today in Initial Order No. 5 of the above Docket by a W.U.T.C. Administrative Law Judge and pending final Commission Approval.

Olympic Pipe Line Company is also seeking less than statutory notice relief to allow the tariff decrease to go into effect on January 1, 2009, in accordance with the provisions of the Amended Settlement Agreement. The delay in filing is directly related to Order No. 5 in Docket TO-031973. This decrease will directly benefit shippers.
