The purpose of this filing is to add a new program to the Company's energy efficiency options that will allow the Company to acquire cost-effective electric energy efficiency resources. The Company will purchase these new resources through its investments in converting existing residential customers from electricity to natural gas for space and/or water heating.

As provided for in the Settlement Terms For Conservation, Exhibit F to the Settlement Stipulation in Docket Nos. UE-011570 and UG-011571, this tariff change was submitted to the Advisory Committee (named the Conservation Resource Advisory Group or "CRAG") at least two months prior to the proposed effective date and it has been reviewed by the CRAG. This program was discussed with the CRAG in 2008 before submitting this program and tariff change to the CRAG on November 20, 2008. This program is also consistent with the Company's previous two Integrated Resource Plans accepted by the WUTC. Up until the date of this filing the Company has not received any comments or suggested changes from the CRAG.

The tariff sheets described herein reflect issue dates of December 19, 2008, and effective dates of January 19, 2009. Notice of the proposed tariff change, as required by law and the Commission's rules and regulations, is being given to the public immediately prior to or coincident with the date of this transmittal letter, through web, telephone and mail access in accordance with WAC 480-100-193(1).
