Cascade Natural Gas Corporation ("Cascade") encloses for filing for the purpose of housekeeping the following tariff sheet containing an effective date of March 20, 2009.

Second Revision Sheet No. 300 Canceling Substitute First Revision Sheet No. 300

The purpose of this filing is to clarify the required minimum R-values for floor insulation eligible for incentive through Cascade's Conservation Incentive Program in Washington State.


Current tariff language mistakenly provides incentives for bringing floor insulation levels to only R-11 or more. This is a misprint. The language should instead specify a minimum of R-30 "or to fill cavity."

Current Building Code dictates that the minimum R-value for floor insulation in Washington State is "R-30 or to R-19 fill cavity." Phrasing the revised language to read "R-30 or to fill cavity" will provide clear guidance for trade allies in the standardized language of their trade.

A Less Than Statutory Notice request is being made in order to accommodate the desired March 13, 2009, effective date. Given the timing of the submittal, the 30-day statutory notice cannot be met. Accordingly, the Company requests a waiver of statutory notice to permit approval by the requested effective date of March 13, 2009.
