Dear Mr. Danner:

Puget Sound Energy, Inc. (the "Company" or "PSE") hereby submits proposed revisions to its electric Schedule 26, Large Demand General Service. This filing, pursuant to RCW 80.28.060 and Chapter 480-80 WAC, proposes revisions in the following electric tariff sheet.

WN U-60, Tariff G - (Electric Tariff):

Third Revision of Sheet No. 26-a - Large Demand General Service (Continued)

The purpose of this filing is to incorporate revisions in the methodology for determining the billing demand for customers who choose to take primary voltage service under Schedule 26. Primary voltage service under Schedule 26 is an optional schedule for all customers presently taking service under Schedule 31. These revisions result in the billing demand for primary voltage customers under Schedule 26 to be the same as the billing demand from primary voltage customers under Schedule 31.

There are no customers taking primary voltage service under Schedule 26 at this time, therefore, this filing does not impact any customers or the Company's revenue.

Even though WAC 480-80-123(3)(d) provides that no statutory notice period is required for a change to a tariff that does not affect the public, the Company is providing thirty days notice to the Commission of this change. The tariff sheet described herein reflects an issue date of October 5, 2009, and an effective date of November 5, 2009. Posting of proposed tariff change, as required by WAC 480-100-193, is being made by posting the proposed tariff sheet on the PSE web site immediately prior to or coincident with the date of this transmittal letter.

This tariff change does not increase recurring charges or restrict access to services to any customer. Therefore, notice of proposed tariff change, as required by law and the Commission's rules and regulations (including WAC 480-100-195), is being given to the public immediately prior to, or coincident with, the date of this transmittal letter through web, telephone and mail access in accordance with WAC 480-100-193.
