#### NOTICE OF PROPOSED RATE INCREASE

To Our Valued Customers:

Thank you for your support of our garbage service. We are always working hard to provide superior service to you, as well as working to keep our costs as low as possible.

We understand the struggle every hard-working American is having. In today's economy, it is hard to pay our bills and to take care of our families. That is why it has been so hard to make the difficult decision to request a rate increase for our collection of your solid waste. Our last rate increase was in 2003, almost seven years ago.

Over those seven years, our costs have increased for every major expense, from medical insurance costs to the cost of our collection vehicles to fuel for the vehicles to employee labor by an average of over 3% per year for a total of 18% to 25%, in some cases.

This economic climate has reached dimensions beyond our current memories of other slowdowns. Up to this year, we were able to put off a rate increase by using our growth in customers to offset some of cost increases we have faced. However, growth has now been negative this last year and we are forced to request from the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (the commission) a rate increase for residential customers that is between 8% to 9% and a commercial customer increase of between 8% to 9.5%. A comparison of the current rates and the proposed rates is presented on the back of this notice. Please understand this decision has not been easy for us to make, knowing our valued customers are struggling, too. We have requested a December 1, 2009 effective date.
