Washington Exchange Carrier Association (WECA) submits herewith the original and three copies of the revisions to Washington Exchange Carrier Association Tariff WN U-2 as referenced above.

This filing revises tariff language related to late payment penalty. The current tariff language references a Commission rule that no longer exists. The replacement language establishes a late payment rate equal to the amount included in the NECA tariff. The filing also changes the penalty rate on a disputed payment to match the rate charged for late payments.

In addition, the filing establishes a customer charge for notice of disconnection or notice of nonpayment where a customer incurs more than one such notice within any twelve-month period.

Mr. Robert Smith is authorized to issue the tariff sheets on behalf of the member companies. Mr. Craig Phillips is authorized by WECA to file the revised tariff sheets with the WUTC.
