

I am writing to request that you consider updating your rules governing prepaid calling providers contained in WAC 480-120-265. Specifically, I am interested in seeing these rules require that: (1) the disclosure of rates, terms and conditions be made in the language that the card is advertised in; and (2) the number of minutes contained on the card be disclosed on the card or its packaging.

These protections are contained in federal legislation currently pending before Congress, H.R. 3993. I would like to see similar protections incorporated in our state.

## Dear Representative Hudgins:

Thank you for your letter requesting that the Utilities and Transportation Commission consider updating WAC 480-120-264, our rule on pre-paid calling services. You specifically propose changes to require disclosure of (1) terms and conditions in the language in which the card is advertised, and (2) the number of minutes contained on the card or its packaging.

I believe a review of this rule is appropriate, and I have asked the Commission staff to commence a rulemaking on the matter during the first quarter of 2010 by preparing a Preproposal Statement of Inquiry, as required by the Administrative Procedure Act as a prerequisite to proposing a rule. We will inform you when this step is taken and when we develop draft rule. We hope that you will consider participating during the rulemaking process.
