Pursuant to Part 35 of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission's (FERC) regulations, 18 C.F.R. Part 35 (2009), Puget Sound Energy, Inc., (PSE) hereby provides the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission's (WUTC) service copy of PSE's proposed revisions to its Open Access Transmission Tariff (OATT), filed at the FERC on February 4, 2010 in Docket No. ER10-723-000. An electronic copy has also been sent to the WUTC Records Center *via* email on February 5, 2010.

As described more fully in the enclosed document, PSE's FERC filing seeks to revise its OATT Schedule 5 ("Operating Reserves—Spinning Reserve Service) and Schedule 6 ("Operating Reserve—Supplemental Reserve Service") to clarify the transmission customer reserve obligations with respect to generation that is exported to load outside of its Balancing Authority Area (BAA). In addition, PSE seeks to add a new Schedule 13 entitled "Regulation and Frequency Response Service for Generators Selling Out of Control Area" and to add language to its Schedule 3 ("Regulation and Frequency Response Service") to address issues of double recovery consistent with proposed new Schedule 13.
