Dear Mr. Danner:

Pursuant to RCW 80.28.060, WAC 480-80-101 and -105 please find enclosed for filing the following proposed revisions to the WN U-2, tariff for natural gas service of Puget Sound Energy, Inc. (the “Company” or “PSE”):

8<sup>th</sup> Revision of Sheet No. 116-A – Natural Gas Schedule No. 16 (Continued): General Gas Lighting and Street Lighting Service (Optional)

The purpose of this filing is to decrease rates for all gas lights and restructure the rate to provide the same rate per gas mantle for all mantles. Through research into the basis for the rate in this schedule PSE determined that the rate reflected the amortization of the underground service and regulator for each gas light. As the Company has not installed gas lights under this schedule since 1973, the plant investment is fully amortized. Should the Company decide to offer service to gas lights in the future the plant investment would be considered under Rule 7, therefore, this revised rate would be appropriate.

Work papers are enclosed showing the calculation of the revised rate. These work papers also show that the overall impact of this change is a decrease of \$3,931 in Company revenue for the 770 mantles billed during the 2008 test year used in Docket No. UG-090705.

The tariff sheets described herein reflect an issue date of May 12, 2010, and effective dates of June 12, 2010. Posting of proposed tariff changes, as required by law and the Commission’s rules and regulations, is being completed immediately prior to or coincident with the date of this transmittal letter through web, telephone and mail access in accordance with WAC 480-90-193.

As these changes result in a decrease in charges to customers, pursuant to WAC 480-90-195(3) notice to customers will be provided in accordance with the method that the Company posts its tariffs as required by WAC 480-90-193.
