The purpose of this filing is to clarify transportation service Schedules 31T, 41T, 85T, 86T and 87T by removing the references to provisions in Schedules 31, 41, 85, 86 and 87 (respectively). For example, prior to this change Schedule 87T contained a provision which stated that "All provisions of Schedule 87 apply to service under this schedule except those provisions of Schedule 87 replaced by Section 3 below and the provisions of Schedule 87 in the section titled Unauthorized Use of Gas which is replaced by the provisions in Rule 29 with the same section title." This filing removes such cross references and adds the provisions of the corresponding schedule to each of the transportation service schedules. The majority of the changes are simply including additional language that was previously included by reference and these changes are coded with a "T" in the margin to signify a change in text for clarification.

The tariff sheets described herein reflect an issue date of May 26, 2010, and effective dates of June 26, 2010. Posting of proposed tariff changes, as required by law and the Commission's rules and regulations, is being completed immediately prior to or coincident with the date of this transmittal letter through web, telephone and mail access in accordance with WAC 480-90-193. As these changes do not restrict access to service pursuant to WAC 480-90-195(3) notice to customers will be provided in accordance with the method that the Company posts its tariffs as required by WAC 480-90-193.
