PURPOSE:

Service under this schedule is intended to maximize the efficient utilization of the electricity requirements of residential dwellings through the use of high efficiency washing machines.

AVAILABLE:

In all territory served by Company in the State of Washington and purchased during the period April 15 - July 15, 2005.

APPLICABLE:

To high efficiency washing machines installed in individually metered residential dwellings.

DESCRIPTION:

The Washwise Coupon Incentive Program, in cooperation with the EPA national Energy Star Appliance campaign, April 15 - July 15, 2005, will provide incentives for high efficiency washing machines through a coupon campaign and a network of retail partners.

QUALIFYING EQUIPMENT:

Energy Star washing machines with a Modified Energy Factor (MEF) of 1.42 and above.

INCENTIVES:

MEF	Value
1.42 and above	\$40
1.80 and above	\$60

PROVISIONS OF SERVICE:

To be eligible for the incentive offer, customer must comply with all the terms and conditions listed on the coupon and submit all required information listed on the coupon.

RULES AND REGULATIONS:

Service under this schedule is subject to the General Rules and Regulations contained in the tariff of which this schedule is a part, and to those prescribed by regulatory authorities.
