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REPORTS AS REQUIRED BY WAC 480-123-070 AND WAC 480-123-080

Skyline Telecom Inc. (the "Company") hereby submits the following reports in accordance with WAC 480-123-070 and WAC 480-123-080¹.

Report 1: WAC 480-123-070 (1)(a): Attached is a copy of the NECA-1 for the calendar year 2009 that the Company has reported as the basis for support from the federal high cost fund.

Report 2: WAC 480-123-070(1)(b): The company reports that the investments and expenses reported under Report 1, above, benefited customers as follows:

Through the expenditure of these funds, the Company was able to continue to provide services at a level that the Company believes meets the intent of providing quality telecommunications services to customers in the service area for which the Company is designated as an ETC². The Company has made substantial investments over the past few years which allow it to provide quality telecommunications services to all of its customers. These expenditures and investments benefit all customers within the designated ETC service area. The Company offers services comparable to services offered in urban areas at rates comparable to such urban areas.

Throughout 2010 the Company has also continued to provide maintenance to the buried cable and other plant as needed to maintain a high level of service quality.

Report 3: WAC 480-123-070(4): The Company reports that during calendar year 2009, the Company did not receive from the Federal Communications Commission or the Consumer Protection Division of the Office of the Attorney General of the State of Washington any complaints against the Company made by the Company's customers.

Report 4: WAC 480-123-070(7): The Company reports that newspaper advertisements detailing basic supported services as well as the Lifeline and Link-Up programs were run in The Okanogan Valley Gazette Tribune throughout 2009. The Company expects to continue to advertise these services throughout 2010.

Report 5: WAC 480-123-080(1)(b): The Company expects investments and expenditures to remain fairly consistent with prior years in relation to maintenance, replacement and upgrades to our plant. The Company does not anticipate major adjustments in staffing levels for the relevant period. Customers will continue to receive the high level of telecommunications service that they have experienced over the past few years with the possibility of increased services.

Report 6: WAC 480-123-080(2): The Company expects investments and expenditures to remain fairly consistent with prior years in relation to maintenance, replacement and upgrades to our plant. The Company has not yet started the budgeting process for 2011 and therefore does not have final numbers prepared for investments and expense levels for 2011. The Company does not anticipate major adjustments to staffing levels in 2011. Customers will continue to receive the high level of telecommunications service that they have experienced over the past few years with the possibility of increased services. The Company expects that the continued receipt of federal high-cost support will allow the Company to continue to provide the supported services at rates comparable to the rates for such services in urban areas to all customers in the designated ETC service area.

² The term "ETC" is used in the same sense as the term is used in Chapter 480-123 WAC.

- I, Linda Kluser, being of lawful age, state that I am Vice-Pres, Many of Skyline Telecom Inc ("Company"), that I am authorized to execute this Affidavit on behalf of the Company, and that the facts set forth in this Affidavit are true to the best of my knowledge, information and belief. On this basis, I hereby certify to the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission ("Commission") for use by the Commission in providing the certification to the Federal Communications Commission and Universal Service Administrative Company required by 47 C.F.R. §54.314, as follows:
- (1) That the Company will use federal high-cost universal service fund support only for the provision, maintenance and upgrading of the facilities and services for which the support is intended;
- (2) That during the 2009 calendar year, the Company met substantially the applicable service quality standard found in WAC 480-123-030(1)(h);
- (3) That during the 2009 calendar year, the Company maintained the ability to function in emergency situations under the standard found in WAC 480-123-030(1)(g), as such standard relates to functionality of wireline carriers in emergency situations; and
- (4) That during the 2009 calendar year, the Company publicized the availability of its applicable telephone assistance programs in a manner reasonably designed to reach those likely to qualify for service and in a manner which, in the Company's judgment, included advertisements likely to reach those who are not current customers of the Company within the Company's designated service area.
