NOTE A - SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Basis of Accounting

The Company's policy is to prepare its financial statements on the income tax basis of accounting which is a comprehensive basis of accounting other than generally accepted accounting principles.

Nature of Operations

The Company is engaged in both commercial and residential sandblasting and painting, and construction of commercial and residential structures. The Company sells and rents shipping containers and other equipment. The Company also does restoration of fire damaged structures. These services are provided primarily within a 100 mile radius of Lewiston, Idaho.

Inventory

Inventory, valued at cost, consists of shipping containers and construction equipment purchased for resale.

Vehicles and Equipment

Property and equipment are carried at cost. Depreciation of property and equipment is provided using the accelerated cost recovery system and the modified accelerated cost recovery system required by the Internal Revenue Code for tax reporting purposes. This involves depreciation over five and seven year lives while taking maximum advantage of IRC Section 179 expensing elections. In tax year 2009 the company elected to expense under IRC Section 179 \$66,460 in equipment purchases which is included as a part of Depreciation Expense. Expenditures for major renewals and betterments that extend the useful lives of property and equipment are capitalized. Expenditures for maintenance and repairs are charged to expense as incurred.

Income Taxes

The Company has elected to be taxed under the provisions of Subchapter S of the Internal Revenue Code. Under those provisions, the Company does not pay federal corporate income taxes on its taxable income. Instead, the stockholders are liable for individual federal income taxes on their respective shares of income to be reported on their individual income tax returns.

Advertising Costs

The Company expenses advertising costs as they are incurred. Advertising expense was \$23,075 for the year ended December 31, 2009.

Use of Estimates

The preparation of financial statements in conformity with the income tax basis of accounting requires management to make estimates and assumptions that affect reported amounts and disclosures. Accordingly, actual results could differ from those estimates.

Revenue Recognition

The Company records profits or losses on its building contracts on the completed-contract method for federal income tax purposes. Under that method, billings and costs are accumulated during the period of construction, but no profits are recorded before substantial completion of the work (usually at the time of final closing). There were no contracts in progress at year end.

Accounts Receivable

There are no significant concentrations of credit risk. The Company looks at overdue accounts on a case by case basis and uses the direct write-off method for accounting for uncollectible accounts.

NOTE B - RELATED PARTY TRANSACTIONS

Steve Carlton Construction, Inc. performed significant work for Steve Carlton personally during 2009. This included construction of an addition to a commercial building owned by Steve Carlton, remodel of a residence held for sale by Steve Carlton, construction of a mini storage facility, and construction of a new commercial rental building. The total cost of this work was \$862,237 including direct cost and overhead. Steve Carlton reimbursed the Company for all costs associated with this work through cash deposits and dividend distributions.
