The purpose of this filing is to update conservation service programs in accordance with the Plan. The above revisions are included as Exhibit 5 to the Plan and clarify terminology, update regulatory code or industry references and address significant changes in program strategies.

In accordance with Condition K(8)(b) of the Electric Settlement Terms for Conservation in Docket No. UE-100177, Conservation Resource Advisory Group ("CRAG") members were provided a complete set of the Plan, including all exhibits on November 1, 2010, in order to allow for comments and questions prior to this filing. The CRAG is the "advisory committee" established in section D of the Electric Settlement Terms for Conservation in Docket No. UE-100177. To date, the Company has provided responses to all questions from CRAG members

relative to the Plan and will continue to address all questions going forward. The Company has not received any comments or questions from CRAG members regarding the proposed changes to the tariff sheets in this filing.

Exhibits 1 through 4 and 6 of the Plan reflect information for the 2011 Plan year will be posted on PSE.com as replacements for the present Appendices A through D which were for the 2010 year. Exhibit 5, Tariff Revisions, of the Plan reflects the revisions made in the Plan for 2011.

It should be noted that electric service rates are not affected by this filing, since the filing does not include any requested change in the Electricity Conservation Service Rider. That filing will be made on approximately March 1, 2011, with a requested effective date of May 1, 2011.

The tariff sheets described herein reflect issue dates of December 1, 2010, and effective dates of January 1, 2011. Notice of proposed tariff changes, as required by law and the Commission's rules and regulations, is being given to the public immediately prior to or coincident with the date of this transmittal letter through web, telephone and mail access in accordance with WAC 480-100-195(3) by posting the proposal in accordance with WAC 480-100-193(1).
