The Company is required by WAC 480-90-238(4) to file its natural gas Integrated Resource Plan within two years after the date of which the previous plan was issued – i.e., in Avista's case, by December 31 of each odd-numbered year. WAC 480-90-238(4) provides:

<u>Unless otherwise ordered by the Commission</u>, each natural gas utility must submit a[n] [IRP] within two years after the date on which the previous plan was filed with the Commission. Not later than twelve months prior to the due date of a plan, the utility must provide a work plan for informal commission review. (emphasis added)

The Company has identified three areas of significant workflow that currently overlap and occur in the fall of each year: PGA filings, Avista's procurement planning, and IRP drafting/review/finalizing. Two of the three activities occur in advance of the start of each natural gas year in November – namely, PGA filings and procurement planning. The third activity (the IRP) in theory does not have to be performed at the same time as the PGA filings and the Company's procurement planning – both of which place considerable demands on Avista and its stakeholders for review. Accordingly, Avista, Commission Staff, and other stakeholders who participate in the IRP process are recommending a permanent shift of that calendar of key IRP dates away from the fall. Provided as Attachment A is a proposed IRP "Activity Timeline," shifting the filing of Avista's next natural gas IRP from December 31, 2011 to August 31, 2012.

It should also be noted that, in accordance with WAC 480-100-238(4), the Company also files its Electric IRP on August 31<sup>st</sup> of each odd-numbered year. A shift in the required filing date for the <u>natural gas</u> IRP would provide a staggered filing for the Company's two IRP's, and avoid an overlap in participation in the two separate plans by the stakeholder groups.

Avista has discussed the shift in the natural gas IRP filing dates with Staffs in Washington, Idaho and Oregon, all of whom support the proposal and have agreed that this would allow for a more thorough and efficient review of the natural gas IRP, given conflicting priorities. Ultimately, the quality and thoroughness of the review process will

be enhanced. Moreover, the Company, for its part, agrees to provide a natural gas demand update to the Commission between the time this request is approved and when the Company would otherwise make its next natural gas IRP filing in August 2012, in order to allay any concerns about a delay in the filing of the 2012 IRP.

For these reasons, the Company respectfully requests that the Commission modify the filing deadline for the Company's natural gas IRP to August 31<sup>st</sup> of each even-numbered year, commencing with the filing of the 2012 IRP by August 31, 2012. WAC 480-90-238 contemplates that the Commission may, by order, modify the prescribed filing dates for good cause shown. The forgoing Petition enjoys the support of the stakeholders in the IRP process and is in the public interest.
