The purpose of this filing is to implement a pilot carbon offset program as described in Transaction Commitment No. 54 in the Multiparty Settlement Stipulation, attached as Appendix A to the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission's Order No. 8, in Docket No. U-072375. This voluntary program will provide natural gas customers the option to contribute to regional projects which will reduce or capture greenhouse gas emissions beginning April 1, 2011.

This filing also makes house keeping changes to Schedule Nos. 101 and 106. Those changes are the removal of references to Schedules 36 and 51 which have been cancelled. The index is updated to reflect the addition of the Carbon Offset Pilot program.

The tariff sheets described herein reflect an issue date of February 4, 2011, and an effective date of March 7, 2011.
