Olympic Pipe Line Company hereby files tariff **Supplement 4 to W.U.T.C. 17** to make the following updates to its Rules and Regulations:

1. The name and address details of the "Issued by" and "Compiled by" contacts have been updated.
2. Rule No. 1 – Carrier name was corrected.
3. Rule No. 2a – The upper limit of the specification for API gravity has been increased from 70 to 72 API degrees.
4. Rule No. 7a – The references to the Fredonia, Spanaway, Olympia, Linnton and Portland delivery facilities have been removed.
5. Rule No. 9e – The 24 hour notice requirement has been removed.
6. Rule No. 13b – In the event a lien on payment is enforced, Shipper will be notified via overnight mail.
7. All references to the Olympic Pipe Line Specification Manual (Rule Nos. 10 & 18) have been updated to include the website address, www.Olympic-Pipeline.com.
