The purpose of this filing is to add Line Hunting. Line Hunting provides customers with more than one line the ability to have incoming calls automatically directed to the next vacant line. The Line Hunting selection process starts at a particular line or directory number and continues in a fixed sequence, until an idle line is found or arrives at the end of the sequence. The service is available with Residential and Business one-party lines. This service is currently tariffed at Asotin at the same rate of \$2.00.

Revenue Projections are also enclosed and are estimated to be under \$1,000 annually.

The proposed effective date is October 1, 2011.
